



## Ski Trip Permission & Sign-up sheet Grades 5 - 8

On Thursday, February 18th, 2010, Pearl City Schools will provide an opportunity for students in grades 5 - 8 to travel to Chestnut Mountain, in Galena for a skiing trip. The "Learn to Ski & Snowboard Program" is both fun and educational for all students to participate in. The cost of the field trip is \$22.00, which includes an all day lift ticket, ski or snowboard rental, a mandatory one-hour group ski/snowboard lesson, and lunch. Lunch would consist of a choice of a sandwich (Hamburger, Cheeseburger, Sloppy Joe, or Hot Dog), Fries or Chips and a Drink.

We will leave Pearl City at 1:00 and return by 10:00. We would suggest snow pants and warm clothing for the field trip. The children will have the opportunity to lock their belongings in a locker for .75 cents. Please do not include this in with your payment. Instead send three quarters with your child to use for a locker.

This is a voluntary field trip and the decision to send your child is totally up to the parents.

**Pearl City Schools are not responsible for any injuries that might occur.**

We understand that this is a school night, however if students attend this field trip they will be required to be at school the next day on time. Students who cause problems on the trip will be disciplined accordingly. Administrators and teachers will accompany and supervise the students on the field trip. The attached form must be completed and signed if your child is to participate in this event.

On Wednesday, February 3rd, we will have an in school assembly for those interested students to familiarize the students with rental equipment, what to wear, the importance of their lesson, and to preset all the student's equipment. If your child is interested in attending this ski trip they must attend this meeting. **Please submit the permission slip along with the attached completed rental equipment agreement and payment by Wednesday, February 3rd, 2010. Checks must be made payable to Pearl City Schools.**

NOTE: High School Students cost is \$40 with out skis and \$20 with skis and lunch is not provided.
